

Tips for gathering your HHW for safe disposal



Seal containers tightly.

Bring items in their original containers inside a sturdy box.

If original container is leaking or damaged, transfer product to a safe container and re-label.

Don't mix products together.

Rechargeable batteries are a fire hazard.

Please bring rechargeable batteries in separate plastic bags to Bozeman Convenience Site or Logan Landfill during regular business hours. The scale attendants will take them. You can also drop off your batteries at the HHW drop off, Radio Shack, Home Depot (rechargeable batteries only) or Batteries Plus. Please tape terminals on batteries and keep alkaline batteries and lithium batteries separated.

Latex paint is not considered hazardous. Solidify it with sawdust, dirt, kitty litter, etc. and place in trash.

E-WASTE
Do not bring e-waste to HHW events. It is accepted at Logan Landfill for recycling during normal hours for a fee. Visit GallatinSolidWaste.org for a list of other options in the area.

OTHER OPTIONS
The Logan Landfill accepts oil, antifreeze, batteries, triple-rinsed pesticide containers, propane cylinders & tanks during regular business hours Monday through Saturday.

- Ammunition:** Take to the Sheriff's Department
- Ballasts:** PCB take to HHW event; NON-CPB Ballasts are recyclable
- Electronics:** Take to Logan Landfill or drop off on E-Waste Day in April
- Latex Paint:** Dry out paint or solidify it with kitty litter, sawdust, dirt or shredded paper; dispose in regular trash
- Prescription Medicine:** Drop off boxes are available at the Belgrade, Bozeman, Manhattan and West Yellowstone police departments and the Law and Justice Center
